


NEWS LETTER September Newsletter of Bellavista Nursing Home Cardiff





Here's what else we got up to this month















Bellavista Nursing Home continues to take the coronavirus situation very seriously and follow guidance from the Welsh Government (WG), Public Health Wales (PHW) and Cardiff Council. Temporary suspension of outdoor visits have been extended by a further week. This decision was not made lightly but to protect our residents and staff from harm given the increasing trend of lockdowns including Cardiff as well as the number of cases rising in Cardiff. The Second wave of the outbreak appears to have started and it is only correct that we do everything within our power to protect everyone living and working in the home. A review with regard to visitation will be conducted on 5th October and we will communicate with you further. We will be taking this time to look into further measures to make the outdoor visiting more feasible during the winter months and to upgrade our Gazebo Visiting Point. Please rest assured we have still not had a positive case within the home but we cannot afford to be complacent, our staff are still tested fortnightly and residents if Symptomatic. We will keep you updated as and when we make changes to our visiting policy. Special arrangements will however be made for indoor visits with full PPE in certain end of life care and extenuating situations.
